Choosing the right coverage

Second, what is your budget for coverage? Make sure this is practical for your event size and the area of coverage. Third, what kind of medical staff do you need? Do you need an EMT, Paramedic, or Athletic Trainers? Fourth, where are you? How long will EMS take to arrive and how

long will EMS take to get to a hospital? Last, know the history of your events medical past, know what other events like yours have had and planned for the worst. EPPC staff can help you find the right coverage just call our main office.

Basic Coverage

Your basic package is great for sport events, small scale horse and dog shows as well as events that do not need more than one EMT. This package gives you the basic care you need in case something should happen. You will get an EMT-B dressed appropriately for the occasion. Either a EMT clean dress uniform or for more high scale events, a suit and tie. The EMT will have communication with the local ambulances, and police departments. Emer-

gency Basic Life Support equipment as well as radio communications with our base in case more help is needed mid event.

This package can be booked with either 1 or 2 EMT's and a First Responder if needed. The EMT's will stay close but out of the way of your event unless called upon.

There is no vehicle with this package ,EMT is on foot.

ALS and BLS Rapid Response

When you have an event that has a history of serious injuries, or has the potential for a serious injury, you might want to consider adding an ALS and BLS combination team to your event. ALS or Advanced Life Support is the highest level of pre hospital ground care. With this package you will get a Paramedic, EMT-B, and a vehicle as well as medical control.

ALS heart monitoring equipment, AED, IV supplies and pain control medications are all included. Medical staff will have communication to local EMS, Fire, and Police Departments for better patient care and communication between on site EMS and the responding Ambulance. This is a great package for Mud Runs and triathlons.

ADVANCED COVERAGE

1 EMT- Paramedic and 1 EMT-Basic with Vehicle.

ALS Heart Monitor and IV supplies.

Uniformed Staff and Equipment.

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Mobile Coverage

This coverage is for those events that have a large areas to cover, and where the majority of the attendants are on the move. Mainly used for bike races, road races and triathlons. This selection gives you a pre-determined number of registered and fully equipped emergency response vehicles. Each

vehicle is equipped with medical supply's, road closing material and emergency red and blue lights. The vehicles used are approved by the RMV for emergency use. With this the vehicle units can shut down parts of a course, move fast to incidents, and scout ahead for dangers in the route.

MOBILE COVERAGE

Equipped Emergency Vehicle (Non-Ambulance) with lights, radios, and medical equipment.

EMT-B or higher in a vehicle with equipment for several situations.



Bike/ Mounted Response Unit

This option gives you the quickest off road mobile coverage. When you book either the Bike Response Unit or the Mounted Unit you get a highly trained and certified team of EMT's on either Bikes or Horses. Our Bike Unit comes with an EMT that has a bike with lights, medical first response bags, and radio communication. The EMT is able to move fast off road, or on the trail. This is great for Bike and foot races that are not in

an area where vehicles can drive easy. They are quick, and highly skilled.

The Mounted Unit much like the Bike Unit is quick, mobile, and highly trained. However, this unit will be on horse back. This unit carries limited equipment only the essential supplies for stabilization but has communication to staged units that are ready to make there way in. Our horses are all highly trained and used to be-

ing around people, and busy situations. This is a great unit for Horse Shows, you don't even know there is EMS support present unless you need them. The Mounted Unit is great for events in the woods as well. Special prices are set upon request. Mounted and Bike Unit come in teams of two only and prerequisites apply for units. Please contact our main office for more information or a quote. Units are seasonal only.



Mobile phone number and call center

If you have an event that needs good communication, or covers a large area with medical staff that are not always close to one another. Our call center and phone number is great for your event. This option gives you a Mobile Command Post or place to receive all medical calls and dispatch all medical units from. It works just like a

police or fire dispatch center. We receive the call and dispatch the right EMS units for the incident. All Radio and phone traffic comes to one spot. You get a emergency phone number that all participants can call for help as well as a trained dispatcher to answer the phone and aid in getting the units to the patient.

Mobile Emergency Care Station's

This option is great for events that have large numbers of people in a confined out door area. The Mobile Medical Care Station is best described as a mini hospital. Our staff will set up the station using walled tents, the size is dependent on how many people you expect at the event. Often we will set

up several at different locations for large event. In each station there are beds for patients in a privet area, with AC, fans, sheets, and pillows. Each tent is assigned a team of staff including but not limited to RN's and EMT's . The tents are equipped with all the medical equipment an ambulance has

and plus some. The stations are great because ambulances have a pre set area to respond to for any transports from the event. Each mobile care station comes with one ATV to move patients that can not get them self's back to the station.
